MCAH working on data clean up for some HMIS participating agencies- reached out to agencies with errors over 5% or more, also LOS and HH move in date errors. Looking for HMIS fiduciary to oversee HMIS grant. Currently MSHDA is acting in this capacity. COC Board has met with an entity that is potentially interested. Coming up on Federal reporting season LSA, etc. What is max number of licenses in Macomb? Process to have more folks licensed in Macomb. Not a max number but can run out of assigned licenses, but can do some work to get some more assigned. Haven't had an issue with bringing on more users.
